France - Information available on 3rd February 2022

Country entry requirements:

If you're fully vaccinated

Fully vaccinated (see 'Vaccination status' below) travellers from the UK must:

- Present a negative PCR or antigen test result taken within 24 hours pre-departure if aged 12 years
- Provide a completed 'sworn statement' (déclaration sur l'honneur) form self-certifying you're not suffering from symptoms associated with coronavirus and have not been in contact with confirmed cases in the preceding fortnight. This can be found on the <u>French government's website</u>

If required, we can support guests to present this information at the airport and border control.

If you're not fully vaccinated

Travellers who are not fully vaccinated will need to self-isolate on arrival in France for 10 days, subject to police checks. This means it will not be possible to accept guests who are not fully vaccinated on a holiday to France.

What to do if you test positive:

If you test positive for coronavirus in France and you're fully vaccinated (including a booster, in line with French pass sanitaire requirements) you must self-isolate for 7 days from the day on which you first develop symptoms, or 7 days from the date of the positive test result. Self-isolation can be reduced to 5 days if you take a negative PCR or antigen test (supervised, not self-administered) on day 5 and you have not displayed any symptoms over the previous 48 hours

In the event of a guest testing positive we will assign one member of the Go beyond team to support the guest through this period. The guest and support team member may need to move to different accommodation if there is not sufficient space to self-isolate in the holiday accommodation. The guest and support team member will have to move to another accommodation when the rental of the accommodation has expired. A rescheduled flight will need to be arranged for the guest and team support member. There will be extra costs incurred in the event of a guest testing positive and we strongly recommend that you acquire sufficient travel insurance to cover this eventuality, or you will be liable for these costs.

Re-entry into England requirements.

If you qualify as fully vaccinated for travel to England, you:

- will not need to take a COVID-19 test before you travel to England or after you arrive
- will not need to quarantine when you arrive
- You will need to <u>complete a passenger locator form</u> before you travel to England.

If required we can support guests to complete a passenger locator form at the required time and present this information at the airport and border control.
