

## Norway - Information available on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2022

### Country entry requirements:

#### If you're fully vaccinated

Travellers from the UK with a valid QR coded UK NHS COVID Pass are required to:

- [complete the online registration form](#) within 72 hours prior to arrival

Your final vaccine dose must have been administered at least 7 days for a double-dose or 21 days for a single-dose vaccine prior to travel. For more on vaccine validity see the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs' guidance on Travel to Norway](#).

#### Proof of vaccination status

Norway will accept the UK's [proof of COVID-19 recovery and vaccination record](#) and proof of COVID-19 vaccination issued in the Crown Dependencies that contains a verifiable QR code at the border. Scottish travellers must have the latest version of the Scottish certification, which includes the verifiable QR code. Your NHS appointment card from vaccination centres is not designed to be used as proof of vaccination and should not be used to demonstrate your vaccine status.

#### If you're not fully vaccinated

Travellers from the UK without a valid QR coded UK NHS COVID Pass are required to:

- complete the [online registration form](#) within 72 hours prior to arrival
- have proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken less than 24 hours before arrival. This does not apply to travellers under the age of 18

#### If you've had COVID-19

Travellers who can prove they have recovered from COVID-19 during the past six months will not be required to provide evidence of a negative pre-departure test on arrival. You will need to be tested within 24 hours of arrival but will only need to quarantine if you have a positive test. You will need to complete the online registration form within the 72 hours prior to arrival.

**If required we can support guests to present this information at the airport and border control.**

### What to do if you test positive:

You will have to self isolate. You can end the isolation when 4 days has passed from when the symptoms appeared, **and** you have not had a fever for at least 24 hours (without having taken antipyretics against fever). This applies whether you are vaccinated or not.

A negative test for the coronavirus is not required to end the isolation.

**In the event of a guest testing positive we will assign one member of the Go beyond team to support the guest through this period. The guest and support team member may need to move to different accommodation if there is not sufficient space to self-isolate in the holiday accommodation. The guest and**

support team member will have to move to another accommodation when the rental of the accommodation has expired. A rescheduled flight will need to be arranged for the guest and team support member. There will be extra costs incurred in the event of a guest testing positive and we strongly recommend that you acquire sufficient travel insurance to cover this eventuality or you will be liable for these costs.

### **Re-entry into England requirements.**

If you **qualify as fully vaccinated** for travel to England, you:

- will not need to take a COVID-19 test before you travel to England or after you arrive
- will not need to quarantine when you arrive
- You will need to [complete a passenger locator form](#) before you travel to England.

If **you do not qualify as fully vaccinated** for travel to England, you will need to:

- show proof of a negative COVID-19 test – test to be taken in the 2 days before you travel to England
- [book and pay for a COVID-19 PCR test](#) – to be taken after you arrive in England
- [complete a passenger locator form](#) before you travel to England

You will need to book the PCR test before you travel.

You will not need to quarantine, unless the result of the PCR test is positive.

**If required we can support guests to complete a passenger locator form at the required time and present this information at the airport and border control.**
