

Romania - Information available on 3rd February 2022

Country entry requirements:

All passengers who are travelling to Romania must complete a [Passenger Locator Form \(PLF\)](#).

The document should be completed no more than 24 hours before entering the country. It can also be completed at the point of entry into the country.

Requirements are country specific. You may get a minimum fine of €600 if you do not comply with the requirements.

The UK is on Romania's "Red List" of countries of high epidemiological risk, this means that regardless of vaccination status, all travellers arriving in Romania from the UK should present a negative PCR test, taken a maximum of 48 hours before arrival.

If you are arriving on public transport (e.g. a flight/coach, etc) this must be taken a maximum of 48 hours before boarding.

If you're fully vaccinated

You must show proof of being fully vaccinated (with both doses of a two-dose vaccine or one dose of a one-dose vaccine) at least 10 days prior to arrival in Romania (date(s) of vaccination must be specified).

If you are fully vaccinated or have a recent certificate of recovery (dated from at least 11 days and a maximum of 180 days before arrival) and have a negative PCR test certificate (taken as above), you do not need to self-isolate.

If you are fully vaccinated or have a recent certificate of recovery (as above) but do not have a negative PCR test (taken a maximum of 48 hours before arrival), you will have to self-isolate for 5 days.

At least 10 days must have passed since your second dose of the vaccine and the vaccine must be approved by the [European Medicine Agency](#) or by the [World Health Organization](#).

If required, we can support guests to present this information at the airport and border control.

If you're not fully vaccinated

Under the Romanian government's current measures, you can only enter Romania from the UK for tourism purposes if you can show proof of being fully vaccinated with both doses of a two-dose vaccine or one dose of a one-dose vaccine authorised by the European Medicines Agency or by the World Health Organisation at least 10 days prior to arrival in Romania. If one of the exemptions listed applies to you, you may be able to present other documentation on entry.

If you're not fully vaccinated but have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last year you can enter Romania. You will need to provide medical documents that attest recovery from COVID-19 and it has to be dated from at least 11 days and a maximum of 180 days before arrival. You will need to provide an additional negative PCR test, taken a maximum of 48 hours before arrival.

You can use the [NHS COVID Pass](#) to demonstrate proof of COVID-19 recovery when entering Romania.

What to do if you test positive:

It is not mentioned on the UK government website how long you have to isolate for should you test positive in Romania, as of 3rd February 2022. We will update this as soon as we know.

In the event of a guest testing positive we will assign one member of the Go beyond team to support the guest through this period. The guest and support team member may need to move to different accommodation if there is not sufficient space to self-isolate in the holiday accommodation. The guest and support team member will have to move to another accommodation when the rental of the accommodation has expired. A rescheduled flight will need to be arranged for the guest and team support member. There will be extra costs incurred in the event of a guest testing positive and we strongly recommend that you acquire sufficient travel insurance to cover this eventuality, or you will be liable for these costs.

Re-entry into England requirements.

If you **qualify as fully vaccinated** for travel to England, you:

- will not need to take a COVID-19 test before you travel to England or after you arrive
- will not need to quarantine when you arrive
- You will need to [complete a passenger locator form](#) before you travel to England.

If you do not qualify as fully vaccinated for travel to England, you will need to:

- show proof of a negative COVID-19 test – test to be taken in the 2 days before you travel to England
- [book and pay for a COVID-19 PCR test](#) – to be taken after you arrive in England
- [complete a passenger locator form](#) before you travel to England

You will need to book the PCR test before you travel.

You will not need to quarantine, unless the result of the PCR test is positive.

If required we can support guests to complete a passenger locator form at the required time and present this information at the airport and border control.
