


The Alpine Adventure Go Beyond in the Mountains

Covid-19

Experience with Covid-19 regulations

During the pandemic, we have followed Covid-19 regulations whilst running supported holidays in England and Scotland, as laid out on the UK government website.

We have used 'bubbles of six', encouraged social distancing wherever possible, and provided everyone with hand-washing stations in the accommodation. Temperatures have been monitored each morning and recorded. Risk assessments were put in place to reduce the risk of transmission, to keep everyone safe and how to act if anyone should display Covid-19 symptoms.

All the policies we have in place are shared in detail with our guests and their support network. We take Covid-19 seriously and we work to keep our guests and team safe.

We recommend that you take out travel insurance to cover any disruptive cost resulting from Covid.
